He does not address one of the main objections to the proposal, which is that if it goes through, accountability and transparency in matters of policy and resourcing of the fire service will be greatly reduced. Mr Bailey urges people to read the proposal, but the PCC website does not have pages or links to other sites where the public can read the case against the proposal. The proposal itself was not part of the PCC's election manifesto. This process goes against basic democratic
