Norfolk Police and Crime Panel – review of revised precept proposal for 2016-17, 16 February 2016, 10am, Edwards Room, County Hall


In accordance with Schedule 5 of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, I write to confirm the Norfolk Police and Crime Panel's decision regarding your revised precept proposal for 2016-17.

The Panel unanimously agreed to support your revised proposal to increase the police and crime element of the council tax in 2016-17 by 1.98% (£4.14 per annum) to £212.94 for a Band D property.
